

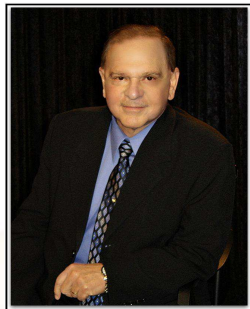

responsibility. Only then will individual and national respect be regained, and the greatness of past years recaptured as, once again, fathers become prominent figures within the family unit.

2. We want to bless 25 gypsy families with food package. Each family needs \$15 for the food package.



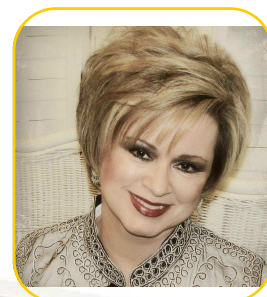

Church/Ministry Tax Dates to Remember

In addition to regular semiweekly and monthly withholding requirements, churches/ministries should note the following dates. Keep good records!

June 15th

1. If you have non-ministerial employees and deposit payroll taxes monthly, the May 2017 payroll tax deposit is due.
2. Ministers must make the estimated tax payment for the second quarter of 2017 using Form 1040-ES. Only make this payment if you believe you will owe taxes for 2017. This is the second installment.
3. If you are a U.S. Citizen or resident alien living and working outside of the United States and Puerto Rico, file Form 1040 and pay any taxes, interest, or penalties due. For an automatic 4 month extension file Form 4868 and deposit estimated tax.

July 17th

1. If you have non-ministerial employees and deposit payroll taxes monthly, the June 2017 payroll tax deposit is due.

July 31st

1. File Form 941 (payroll tax) for the second quarter of 2017 and deposit any unpaid taxes. If your tax liability is less than \$2,500, you can pay it in full with a timely filed return. If you deposited the tax for the quarter timely, properly, and in full, you have until August 10th to file the return.
